We started learning a few Spanish words for Cinco De Mayo earlier this month. We continue to practice colors, and greetings. We know the Spanish words for hat, nap, party, quiet, yes, good, please, class, hello, red, yellow, blue, green, black, white, pink, orange and a few other sayings.

In math we are reviewing everything that we have learned in kindergarten: the number that comes before and after, writing numbers from number words, adding up to 10, counting by 5's (nickels) and 10's (dimes) and 25's (quarters). We are identifying the following shapes: square, triangle, parallelogram, and rectangle etc.

In science we continue to explore seeds and insects! We planted two different types of seeds. We water them daily and have one bean growing. In bible we are learning about the Ten Lepers.



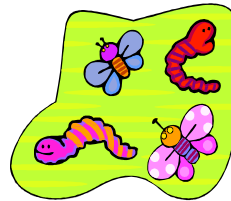
