### Phonics

We are working on “sp” for our special sound this week.

Comprehension is a great skill to work on at home while reading readers, Bibles, or bedtime stories with your student. Asking question about the story is a way to strengthen your students recall and re-tell skills. A great way to do this would be to close the book and have your student re-tell the whole story to you. Another option would be to ask specific questions about the story (example: What did God do on the last day of Creation?).

## Bible

Memory Verse:

**Psalm 100:4a “Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise.”**

**\*We are learning about the ten lepers this week.**

**\*Great questions and discussion starters:**

- Why did the ten lepers need Jesus’ help?
- What are some things God has given to you that you are thankful for (in homework)?
