

## **P.E. Grading Policy For Grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

### **Students are graded on the following:**

1. Participation in class.
2. How well they perform a particular skill or skills covered in class and the amount of effort displayed.

### **Meaning of Numbers:**

- 4 - Exceeding in meeting expectations  
(89.5% or Higher)
- 3 - Meeting expectations  
(89%-74.5%)
- 2 – Needs some improvement on meeting expectations  
(74%49.5%)
- 1 – Needs considerable improvement on meeting expectations  
(49% or lower)

These percentages are not averaged into the academic core classes. During a selected time, a number for each category for each student will be marked in the grade book and Ren Web. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will be tested on specific skills learned in class approximately every three weeks. 3rd-5<sup>th</sup> grade will be graded on skills during selected activities and tournaments. At the end of the trimester the majority of numbers earned will be the students' final grade.
